 designed garden! As the
 years have passed, we
 found that our garden was
 increasingly being taken

 aggressive plants, creating a
 bit of a monoculture. This
 spring we asked two of our
 new 2019 interns with VCE
 Master Gardeners of North-
 ern VA to come up with de-
 sign goals for our full sun,
 southern exposure, dry soil
 garden, and to implement
 the new planting.

These goals are: to educate
 our visitors with the im-
 portance of including pollina-
 tor loving plants in their own
 gardens, to include the na-
 tive plant species which are
 most valuable to pollinators
 in terms of number and di-
 versity of pollinators served,
 to select plants which will
 bloom from early spring to
 late fall in a variety of heights
 and colors, and to show-
 case the beauty of these
 plants so that our visitors will
 be encouraged to add them
 to their traditional flower
 beds as well as their dedi-
 cated pollinator plant beds.
 So grab some hand-outs
 and go visit your local native
 plant sales and stores!
